

PURPOSE AND CONTENTS OF THIS MAP

The designations shown on this motor vehicle use map (MVUM) were made by the responsible official pursuant to 36 CFR 212.51...

It is the responsibility of the user to acquire the current MVUM. This MVUM shows the National Forest System roads, National Forest System trails, and the areas on National Forest System lands in the Gila National Forest...

Designation of a road, trail, or area for motor vehicle use by a particular class of vehicle under 36 CFR 212.51 should not be interpreted as encouraging or inviting use or implying that the road, trail, or area is passable...

This motor vehicle use map identifies those roads, trails, and areas designated for the motor vehicle use under 36 CFR 212.51 for the purpose of enforcing the prohibition at 36 CFR 261.13...

These designations apply only to National Forest System roads, National Forest System trails, and areas on National Forest System lands.

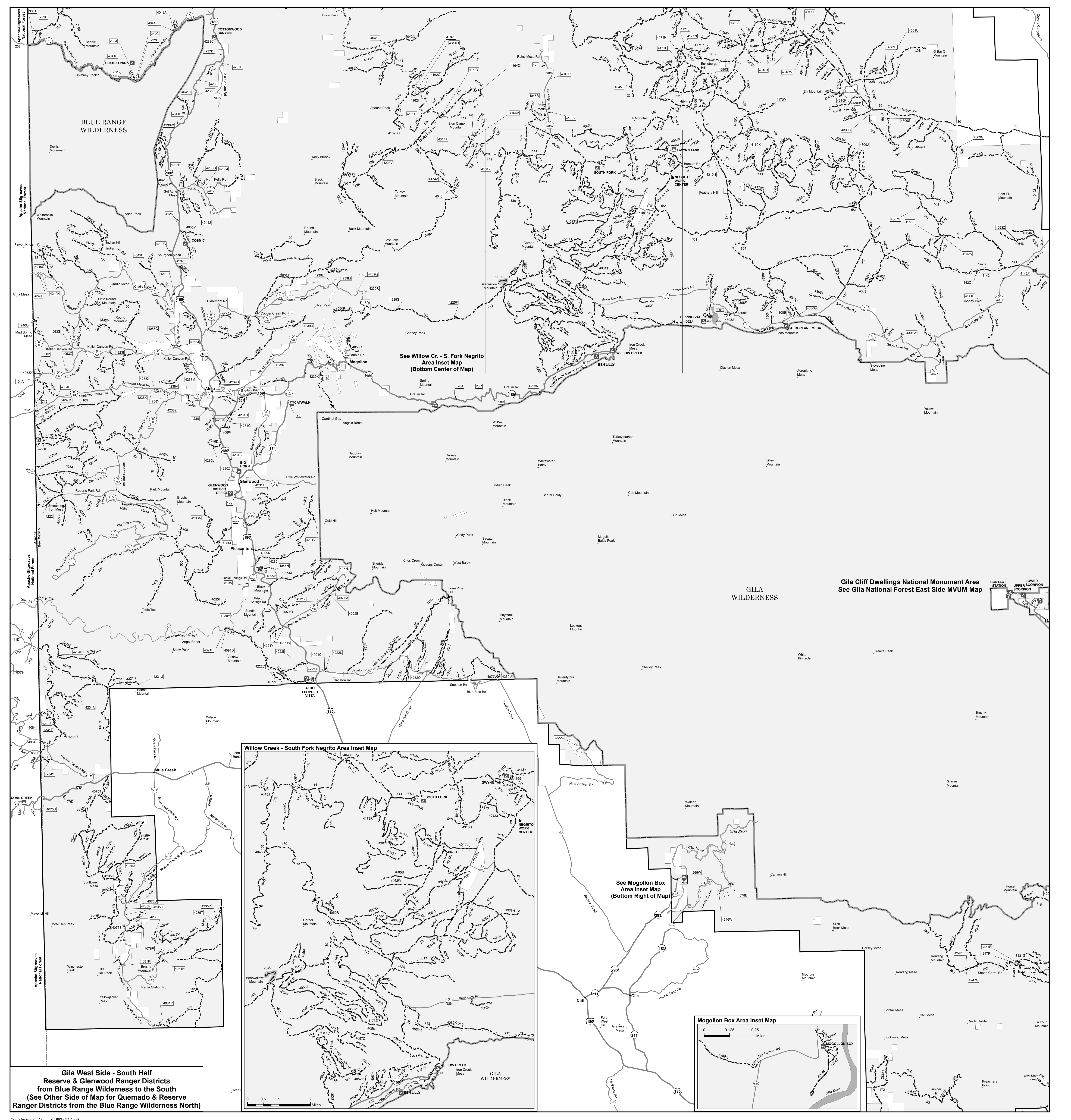
PROHIBITIONS section stating that it is prohibited to possess or operate a motor vehicle on National Forest System lands on the Gila National Forest other than in accordance with designations (36 CFR 261.13).

OPERATOR RESPONSIBILITIES section outlining the requirements for operating a motor vehicle on National Forest System roads, including the need to follow applicable traffic laws and maintain proper control of the vehicle.

Other options for viewing or using this map include downloading a copy of the map using a computer, smartphone, or tablet, and using the Gila National Forest Service mobile app.
